abrdn Bridge Fund, a Sterling denominated sub fund of the abrdn Bridge Fund, Income Inc Shares (ISIN: GB0006441181). This fund is managed by abrdn Fund Managers Limited.

OBJECTIVES AND INVESTMENT POLICY

Investment Objective

To generate growth over the long term (5 years or more) by investing in a diversified portfolio of equities (company shares) and bonds (loans to

a diversified portfolio of equities (company shares) and bonds (loans to governments or companies).

Performance Target: To exceed the ARC Private Client Indices (PCI)

Steady Growth Net Return Index per annum after charges over rolling 3 year periods. The performance target is the level of performance the management team hopes to achieve for the fund. There is however no certainty or promise that it will be achieved.

The manager believes this is an appropriate target for the fund since it reflects the risk and return profile that private clients expect and aligns with the investment policy of the fund.

Investment Policy Portfolio Securities

- The fund invests at least 70% in global equities, corporate investment grade bonds and government bonds issued anywhere in the world.

- The fund may hold other securities and asset classes (e.g.

supranational and other types of bonds and listed real estate) issued anywhere in the world.

The fund may also invest in other funds (including those managed by abrdn), money-market instruments and cash.

Management Process

- The management team use their discretion (active management) to identify holdings based on an analysis of global economic and market conditions (for example, interest rates and inflation) and analysis of a company's prospects and creditworthiness compared to that of the market.

- They focus on selecting companies and bonds and ensuring that the allocation of assets meets the Fund's objectives.

 In seeking to achieve the performance target, a composite index, details of which are provided below, is used as a reference point for portfolio construction and as a basis for setting risk constraints. The expected variation ('tracking error') between the returns of the fund and

the composite index, is not ordinarily expected exceed 5%. Due to the Fund's risk constraints, the intention is that the Fund's performance profile will not deviate significantly from that of the composite index over the longer term.

- Composite Index: 22.5% FTSE All-Share Index, 52.5% FTSE World ex UK Index, 10% FTSE Actuaries UK Conventional Gilts All Stocks Index, 10% ICE BofAML Sterling Non-Gilts Index, 5% SONIA.

Derivatives and Techniques

- The fund may use derivatives to reduce risk, reduce cost and/or generate additional income or growth consistent with the risk profile of the fund (often referred to as "efficient portfolio management").

Derivative usage in the fund is expected to be limited. Where derivatives are used, this would mainly be to manage expected changes in interest rates, companies share prices, currencies or creditworthiness

of corporations or governments.

- The fund may also invest in other funds which may use derivatives extensively although these investments shall be in line with fund's overall risk profile.

Investors in the fund may buy and sell shares on any dealing day (as defined in the Prospectus).

If you invest in income shares, income from investments in the fund will be paid out to you. If you invest in accumulation shares, income will be added to the value of your shares.

Recommendation: the fund may not be appropriate for investors who plan to withdraw their money within five years. Investors should satisfy

themselves that their attitude to risk aligns with the risk profile of this fund before investing.

The fund is rated as 5 because of the extent to which the following risk factors apply:

The fund invests in equity and equity related securities. These are sensitive to variations in the stock markets which can be volatile and change substantially in short periods of time.

The fund invests in securities which are subject to the risk that the

issuer may default on interest or capital payments. The fund price can go up or down daily for a variety of reasons including changes in interest rates, inflation expectations or the perceived credit quality of individual countries or securities.

The fund invests in emerging market equities and / or bonds. Investing in emerging markets involves a greater risk of loss than investing in more developed markets due to, among other factors, greater political, tax, economic, foreign exchange, liquidity and regulatory


